Transnationale partnerschap is compulsory. <u>3 kind of projects</u>



- 1. <u>Joint Development projects</u>: the Flemish promotor will develop together wih a transnational (and national) partners product, instrument, method, system, etc. The project has to be implentational in Flanders,
- 2. <u>Import projects</u>: research and comparison of relevant products, instruments, methods, etc of another member state. The most relevant product will be selected and adjusted to the Flemish context with final goal the implementation of the product in Flanders
- 3. Export projects
